The Mechanical Workshop Supervisor will assist in the manufacture of products at various stages throughout projects and provide mechanical engineering support to other departments, as well as providing direction and supervision to the workshop team. Based in our offices in Carrickfergus, the Mechanical Workshop Supervisor will be a key member of the mechanical engineering team.

Responsibilities:

- Supervise the Mechanical Workshop Team and provide support and direction as required
- Assist with the scheduling of the mechanical job tasks for jobs as required
- The use of workshop machines and tools including lathe and vertical mill
- Mechanical assembly of Yelo products
- Maintain build quality and report any issues to the Manager
- Develop and maintain a maintenance program for the mechanical workshop equipment
- Use bench fitting techniques as required
- Support the operation of CNC machines as needed
- Ensure conformance with ISO9001 procedures
- Carry out any other task that may be required from time to time
